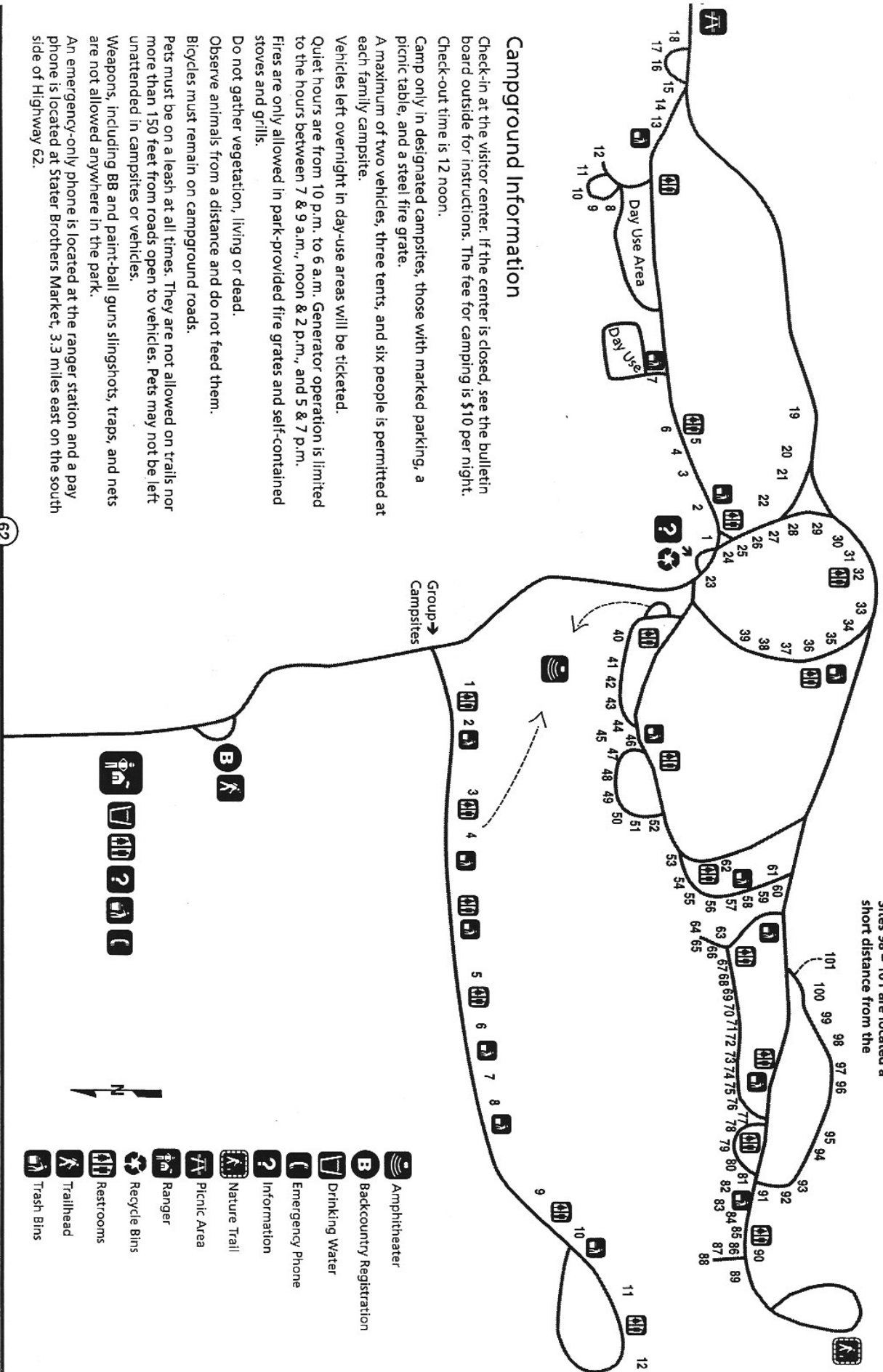


Indian Cove Campground

Campground Information

Check-in at the visitor center. If the center is closed, see the bulletin board outside for instructions. The fee for camping is \$10 per night.

Check-out time is 12 noon.

Camp only in designated campsites, those with marked parking, a picnic table, and a steel fire grate.

A maximum of two vehicles, three tents, and six people is permitted at each family campsite.

Vehicles left overnight in day-use areas will be ticketed.

Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Generator operation is limited to the hours between 7 & 9 a.m., noon & 2 p.m., and 5 & 7 p.m.

Fires are only allowed in park-provided fire grates and self-contained stoves and grills.

Do not gather vegetation, living or dead.

Observe animals from a distance and do not feed them.

Bicycles must remain on campground roads.

Pets must be on a leash at all times. They are not allowed on trails nor more than 150 feet from roads open to vehicles. Pets may not be left unattended in campsites or vehicles.

Weapons, including BB and paint-ball guns slingshots, traps, and nets are not allowed anywhere in the park.
